Hello friends in Christ Jesus

Winter is around the corner and sub zero temperatures are already our experience in the night time here in Romania. Many things have been happening since I last did an update, but that's how life is in general,. Our Lord Jesus gives us many good surprises that equip us to serve others for his glory.

My deep desire spiritually is to grow in the prophetic and attend a prophetic school. But the Lord knows this and sent his servants John and Margot Nairn from Tasmania who have given me great encouragement, teaching, and experience. Rodica and I believe that the Lord is releasing anointing into both our lives in the prophetic role that we believe in faith He has imparted for his use in our life.

Our church in Romania sent us to the annual assembly in south west Romania, and being with God's leaders of Romanian churches was very uplifting and challenging to us. The teaching was great and we invested in teaching DVDs to use in our home church. We have started a weekly house group which is good for fellowship and spiritual nourishment. Rodica now teaches guitar to students from a village church plant and is part of the church worship team. So generally our spiritual lives are being renewed and stretched which is good.

Challenging practical work continues with house number 3 in the village of Danes having a well dug and pipe work fitted. This will also be useful for house number 4. Internal work on this home is moving on with the family helping a lot as well. We have fitted radiators in this house which heats upstairs from the same wood used downstairs.



We have moved on in faith building house 4 in Danes as high as we can though now we need to put in the wood first floor timbers. We don't know yet which Christian family will have this house, but we do know God told us it would be for a family of another denomination, and that we would know the family. We pray the Lord opens doors to continue this house as we have paid 400 pounds for authorisation to build this and it expires in March next year. So we pray we can do this at least to roof height so we don't have to pay the 400 pounds again for authorisation. The law in Romania says that if the house is under a roof it is enough to not have to pay extra paper work to do the inside part.

The house in the village of Soard was completed for the family whose house had been accidentally burnt down. We had help with two houses built with Project Romania in Laslea, and other repairs have been done - particularly to roofs. Requests come daily, but living costs for myself and the men, together with van repairs and insurance, stretch us beyond the limit many times.

However, the Lord has helped with finance from AMEN charity in the UK which has agreed to cover the wages of one of the men throughout next year. But we do pray for other needs including a replacement car for the Dacia which is terminally sick! We urgently need a car in good condition for teams who will be visiting us next year to use and also to enable us to get about for Christian outreach work.

We thank all of you who sacrificially give to us and the work of the Lord here and we speak God's blessing back over yourselves. Take care and God bless from
