I bring you greetings in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, on behalf of Grace & Light staff and volunteers.

Here am I again bringing you the update on the work of Grace & Light, a work that will not be possible without your support, both spiritual and financial. We are grateful and pray that God will continue to bless you abundantly.

"Moving faster than Aids" is still our motto and we are doing our best to stick to it. In this regard, we continue to carry out vision sharing and HIV testing in various churches in different countries.

In the month of September, in Jos only, 461 people were tested after a thorough counselling and testing in five churches. Forty-five rededicated their lives to Christ, and 12 gave their lives to Christ as well. As we wait for reports from other parts to reach us do please pray for the new converts and those that rededicated themselves to continue to grow spiritually.

On the 13th to 28th of September, I was on a ministry trip to Liberia and Sierra Leone, a trip that went well, though with challenges. Have you ever seen a Peugeot wagon with 26 passengers? Not only did I see one but I travelled with it! And on a bumpy and slippery road. But I still thank God for safety in travel and my mission was accomplished. We have new board members in Liberia, the zeal is rekindled in all the teams, and we had an opportunity to share our vision in churches. Keep the two countries in prayer that the Lord will continue to uphold the work.

Another achievement in the month of September was the start of fencing two sides of our permanent site in order to secure it, with three courses of blocks with concrete posts in-between. Some of you have given towards that, again thank you for your contributions.

It is with deep sorrow that we announce the death of one of our faithful supporters, John Cheverton of Oakham School in the United Kingdom after a brief illness. His funeral was on Friday 15th, please keep his family in prayers. One of our board member in Liberia too lost her husband, Mrs. Sando Weeks. Pray for God's peace for the bereaved families.

Please continue to pray for open doors in churches and funding so that we will continue to touch more for the sake of the Gospel.
