Here are some short questions and answers that I asked some of the people who are currently in HUB:

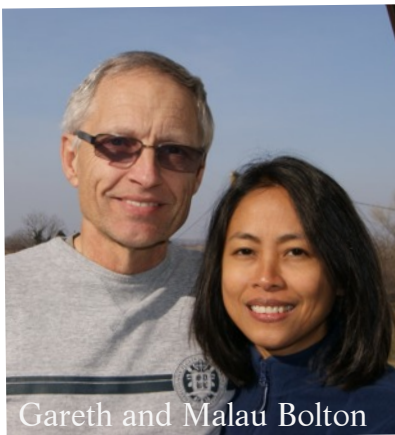
- *How does life at the school influence your life and your relationships with one another?*

People often ask us about the school, studying, possibilities, so here is an opportunity to answer some of the most frequently asked questions of yours:

- *What are the terms for enrolling HUB Bible school Belgrade?*

In the first place, the person has to be a born-again believer who has confirmed his faith by baptism. Along with this, they have to be called by God to study and supported by their local church. The local church has to stand to every believer and pray for them. Also, the candidate has to have an open heart to study, receive messages, allow God to change them through the Word of God and they have to be ready to live in the community with those who might be different from them. By living in the school, every student is a part of a big spiritual family. This is a fantastic opportunity for gaining a huge experience within a short amount of time.

- *How much does a school year cost to students?*

For 16 years, day after day and year after year, God has provided for the needs of the students and everything in the Bible school. A whole army of the people across the world has participated in generous giving of their resources so that the students would have everything

that they need and so that the school would be accessible to everyone. What a grace! Every day, month and year, we live by faith and God has been faithful. We continually thank God for those who faithfully and persistently help this ministry to keep going and for the fact that the students do not have to pay for anything. Also, our professors and teachers, the number of whom is over 100, have been setting aside their time and money to come, be a part of us and serve us.

What great examples they are!

- *How long does the program last and when can it start?*

We have a two year program. The first year is for all those who want to get to know the Scriptures better, grow spiritually, gain life experience through life with other students. This year is open for all the believers who are interested. The second year of the school is for those who want to commit themselves to work at church, mission field, a ministry or something similar. Studies of the first year can start in October, January and April, whereas the second year always starts in October.
