- Levi is an active young man. Actually he is married. He benefited of some help to go see a doctor from Amen fund. He has a problem with his eyes an cataract on top of it. He was told he is on his way to blindness. Recently we helped him go to Bucharest for a second opinion. News is good. His retinopathy is one thing, but the cataract can be operated on. Please pray for a surgery for Levi's eye as soon as possible.*
- On going expense from Amen medical is also the medicine we buy for pregnant ladies in Shoard that Jamie worked with.*
