The school ran for a period of five weeks and at the end of it, we saw zeal and the heart to go and share the experiences with others even the discipleship. At the school, the attendees received training in soap making and cash crop farming. The participants are back to their various locations now: please pray for them to carry on with this work. Doors are open all over for discipleship, but as Jesus said 'The harvest is plenty but the labourers are few'. We pray that God will send us labourers. We will do a special package of what has been happening and send it across in a few months.

Have you seen a man driving for hours and has to go under his vehicle after every twenty five minutes in order to fix some part of the car which was falling at intervals? Well, this was our experience on the first Sunday in the month of March as we journeyed to Gadabiyu for a meeting. To the glory of God, about a hundred and fifty people attended the meeting and they were greatly blessed.
