Greetings and thank you for your support to the ministry in India. We thank you and the Souter Charitable Trust for the donation we received towards our work. In this newsletter we inform you about what your gift has accomplished.

Tailoring machines:

We are able to give 8 tailoring machines to the girls who completed the six month course with us. This picture shows four of the girls who received machines. While I was buying machines we had only four machines in the shop and another 4 machines was given later by David and Pushpa.

All these girls were very happy to receive the machines. With support of AMEN we have given 68 machines so far. It is such an encouragement to know that so many peoples' lives have been changed.



Literacy class:

We have provided much needed stationary and books for the women who are learning to read and write. When they received these materials, they were happy and thanked AMEN for your concern for them.

Water filters:

We had 5 filters left with us, that you gave to us in the past. We were able to buy 5 sets of buckets, tops and pipes. We were able to give 5 water filters to families living in the slums. With help of AMEN so far we are able to give over 40 water filters to families living in the slums.





Tailoring Centre:

18 girls joined the tailoring course. We gave them scissors and measurement tapes. All these girls come from very poor backgrounds. They need scissors to learn tailoring skills for the next six months. They are quality scissors and the girls were surprised to get ones of such good quality.

Tailoring course Graduation:

We were able to buy dresses (Indian saris) for 22 girls who completed the six months course.



We have a small amount of money left over and this is going to be used to purchase education equipment for the Day Care Centre.
