

News from the Village Missionary Movement – June 2010

In May 2010 we reached 430 villages through the Vacational Bible School ministry. We could not reach the planned 1000 villages because of financial constraints.

One thing which is continuously encouraging us is the testimonies which come from various quarters regarding the youth meeting held on May 1. Many rural churches witnessed new young people coming to their Sunday services, in some places the youths who normally opposed the gospel came to Christian fellowships, many were baptized, many Christian young people who were nominal were revived and their churches felt their lively participation.

There is a great opening in many churches for Village Missionary Movement. Many big churches which do not know us are calling us to their churches to share our ministry. Bro.Mohan C.Lazarus was impressed with our way of soul winning and called David Ganesan to share in his one week training program for soul winners in which nearly 1500 attended. Because of that sharing, now, according to the feedback received, more than 1000 new villages are reached by those who participated.

Also the Bishop of Tirunelveli gave his right hand of fellowship to our ministry.

We thank all the AMEN partners for their prayers.

Also because of AMEN's help we are able to start the next Philip Gospel team. We have bought all the equipment and the vehicle will be delivered to us in three or four days. Thank you. May God be glorified.

Please pray for the vehicles and equipment needed to prepare another eight Philip Gospel teams. This is really a most effective approach to reaching into the villages.



One of our next major projects is to build a missionary training centre in the land which was purchased in the past years. The total building will come around 6000 square feet. For one square foot the cost of building will be Rs.1000.(about £14). So the total estimate of cost is sixty lakh rupees.(about £84,000) Please pray for this construction as it is crucial for the future of VMM programs.
