Village Missionary Movement going out to rural villages



- There are **thousands of rural villages in India who have never heard about Jesus**
- The people need to see that Christianity is not just a Western faith but also **an Indian faith**
- Reaching out to isolated communities requires **styles which are culturally accepted** and which demonstrate the love of God in a way they can understand



VMM was formed in 1996 by Santhosh, David Ganesan, and Anand to meet this need.

- To lead rural children to Jesus Christ and to train them to be leaders of the future church and nation.
- To help children achieve their potential through education
- To reach out to parents and villages through the children

VMM teams go out into the remote villages sharing the gospel but also showing that God loves the people in practical ways.

- Currently **512 villages** are being visited regularly by VMM missionaries
- In summer 2008 VMM held **Children's Vacational Bible Schools in 271 villages**
- **BUT** VMM have a vision to be regularly visiting 1000 villages.
- They plan to do this by setting up **8 "Phillip" teams** – equipped to go out to rural villages to conduct small Gospel Meetings where possible, show Christian films, support and encourage local churches, hold children's camps.
- Over **20,000** people will hear the gospel each month from each team!
- **Nearly a quarter of million people can hear the Gospel each year through each team**
