The Gospel Proclaimed to the poor

We praise the Lord for giving us opportunities to share the gospel the last two months. A total of 453 people heard the gospel of Christ and surrendered their lives to the Lordship of Jesus.

Bible Study Groups

People in the urban poor are not only hungry for food made by human beings; they are also hungry for food from God. Their hunger runs deep. At present there are 60 Bible study groups that are being led by our teams. One group may range from 4 to 12 adults. The team of brother Abril Galang has started Bible studies with children. They have 1 group for 3 to 7 years old; 1 group for 8-12 years old; 1 group for 13 years old and above. Twenty-one young people attend this Bible study.

Bibles Distributed

Many people have asked for Bibles, but we have given out a total of 89 Tagalog Bibles and 40 Cebuano Bibles. Another 25 English Bibles are put aside for deaf and mute Bible study of Pastor Amado Reyes Jr. Five of these are already distributed.

Alternative Learning System

The Alternative Learning System is an educational program by the government. This program is designed for people who want to finish high school, but due to poverty have missed the opportunity. Our role in this program is to provide Instructional Managers and teachers who make sure the program is followed. This means that we have to spend and send some of our missionaries for training. We want to see the poor not only developed spiritually but also educationally. As of today there are 26 who enrolled at Camarin under the leadership of Pastor Michel Sabalza. This program will start the first week of April. There were 100 plus people who indicated to enroll in ALS at Pugad Ibon, Kawit, Cavite. However, our team (Pastor Sonny Besmonte, Queenie Matias and Therosebeth Tolentino) are taking 30 students only. It will start on March 17, 2018. We have another team that has started ALS. Ten students are enrolled there.

Believers Discipled

There are 18 young people and 20 adults who are being discipled. We desire to see them become leaders their churches.

Feeding Program for Children

In Cebu our team is feeding 150 children once a week. Food served usually is porridge, rice, or rice with cocoa, soup or rice with sweet potato in coconut milk. Through this ministry we get in touch with their parents. The ultimate goals are to reach out to the parents, and to see the children gain weight and grow in the knowledge of Christ.

Prayer Requests

- 1. Please pray CWTP will find three new slum areas. It is difficult now to find a slum in Metro Manila.
- 2. Pray with us that the Lord will send more missionaries to the urban poor through CWTP. We hope to start training a batch of new recruits in August.

We thank the Lord for your partnership with us in the work of the Gospel among the poor here in the Philippines. Thank you for your prayers and love. We thank the Lord also for giving us opportunities to bring a sense of holistic ministry among the poor.

- Pastor Eric Cubillo works as our North Field Director;
- Floripin Encomio is in charge of the youth camp scheduled on April 19 to 21. We expect 150 young people to come plus 50 staff. She is also part of Mobilization Team tasked to promote our ministry and raise funds in America and Canada.
- Pastor Ely Cotanas, (team leader, member of Leadership Council, in charge of construction of Fairview Building, in charge of ALS, and in charge of Sacred Gift of God Training Center),
- Pastor Marcelo Boot (team leader and member of Leadership Council) and Cristal Aguilar are looking for a suitable slum area.
- I oversee all CWTP ministries as Executive Director and working as Senior Minister at Christ Our Life Fellowship.
