COVID-19 Food Appeal - Report from Tender Heart

As the COVID-19 crisis continues to loom over the people of India, the Government of India has taken a strict combat measure by directing a compulsory lockdown of the entire nation till the 3rd of May. At this great hour of need, Tender Heart has stepped in to provide relief, thanks to your generous donations

Today (15/04/2020) Tender Heart provided 260 grocery sets to the marginalised and low-income segment of the society comprising of daily wage workers, migrant labourers, construction site workers (who can't currently work because of lockdown – so have no income), single mums and those staying in night shelters.

During the distribution of groceries, the team heard many stories from people who are struggling to find food and money to buy vegetables. Many of them wanted to walk back to their home towns, which are hundreds of kilometres away.

Everyone told us our timely groceries sets are feeding their enter family - they are so grateful. These grocery sets will help feed them for 15 to 20 days. The team shared about God's love with people.

So far Tender Heart has distributed 610 grocery sets and tomorrow we will be distributing another 120 groceries kits in North Karnataka.
