Tender Heart works with the Dalits, the most disadvantaged people group in India

The Dalit people live in the slums and do the work no one else wants to do. Our partners, Francis and Alison, have worked with them in Goa since 2007.

Tender Heart run several Day Care Centres for young children, which include education, Bible stories, medical care, lunch and transport. Parents are also offered health care, parenting advice and Bible teaching. This enables the children to stay with their families instead of being sent to an orphanage as often happens.

Dalit women and girls are particularly at risk, because of their severe poverty parents often sell their daughters into the Devadasi system of temple prostitution.

Tender Heart also run tailoring courses and computer training, offering the chance of a future for these forgotten people. Lives have been transformed through this ministry. Girls have been rescued from going into prostitution and given a means of income through a trade learnt at Tender Heart.



AND - 19 EMERGENCY RELIES

Through Tender Heart, adults learn valuable skills which can mean the difference between them having an income or being destitute. Not only that, but the children's work reaches the adults as well.

At the moment in Margao city we operate a Day Care Centre for young children from two small rented rooms which are far from ideal. With a new purpose built centre we can considerably expand the work and provide support and training for many additional families and individuals



What is planned?

The New Life Centre will offer a purpose-built facility for:

- Day Care for Dalit children living in the slums of Margao
- Tailoring Training Centre
- Computer Training Centre
- ♦ Addiction Centre
- Carpentry workshop for young people in the slums
- Various skills workshops
- Counselling Centre for the broken families and those with HIV/AIDS
- Workshops and seminars on health and hygiene for the community
- Sunday worship and Bible studies

This new centre will have a huge impact on the people in the Dalit community. It will empower them to have a better quality of life.
