Dear brothers and sisters.

We are so happy to see how much God has blessed this ministry in the past year since we took responsibility for this project. The numbers are very encouraging, and we can see a wonderful growth on all levels.

- Through advertising, we made contact with 4407 new contacts, which is also twice as much compared to the past 3 years combined.
- During 2023, we sent 608 New Testaments, which is twice as many compared to the past 3 years combined.
- The number of followers on the Facebook page during 2023 increased by 55.3% compared to the past 3 years combined.
- In our daily communication, we shared the Gospel more than 600 times.

This is only a fragment of the statistical data. Although the statistical data is a great encouragement and confirmation, for us the most important thing in this ministry is that we have the opportunity to share the Gospel with people on a daily basis and point them to God. We wrote in more detail about various encouraging testimonies in our monthly reports that you had received over the past year. We just finished the Christmas campaign; it was very successful! We will let you know all about it in our next newsletter.

Because of God's amazing grace and your prayers, we are encouraged to continue to devote our time and effort to the ministry of Isus Mesija (Jesus the Messiah).

Please pray with us that God will continue to lead us and bless the seed we daily sow in people's lives. Sometimes we see more immediate results and sometimes it takes time for people to decide to get in touch with us. Two months after we finished with the campaign about fighting drug addiction, we were contacted by a young man who lives in Germany asking us for help.
