- By the end of the same day friends he had just visited in the USA had asked if there was a specific need they could meet - and the first, a new water purifier, was promised!
- Over the next 48 hours over £1600 was promised towards the second project - installation of solar panels (see above).
- The special collection taken after the service at Emmanuel raised the exact amount needed for the third—purchase of a new rice grinder and cooker. The previous one had deteriorated to the point that staff using it were in danger of receiving electric shocks!
- Four new child sponsorships have also already been set up!

Solar Panels

Keeping cool in Chennai is expensive... as is the cost of cooking meals for over fifty mouths three times a day and other activities that require electricity. At the same time there is lots of sun!

Joseph shared with us the fact that energy costs were over £600 per month but that solar panels would eliminate this amount and enable the Home to export.

We would like to help Joseph fulfil his dream. The first stage is estimated to cost £5000....
