SATURDAY 9

"Last month, the residents of Jebu, a predominantly Christian farming village in the Tahoss District of Riyom County, Plateau State, are mourning the loss of at least 32 community members following an attack by armed Fulani militias. The assault, which began around 3am, left men, women, children, and even a 3-month-old infant dead. the attackers set fire to dozens of homes, destroyed farmlands, and reduced the local church to rubble. Survivors described the attack as sudden and coordinated. Eyewitnesses said the assailants, armed with rifles and machetes, surrounded the community from multiple directions, opening fire on residents as they slept. The quiet of the night was shattered by gunfire, the crackling sound of burning rooftops and the desperate screams of villagers fleeing for their lives". SUNDAY 10

Over the years, a group of committed believers has been gathering faithfully in area M, forming a vibrant church community despite significant material limitations. The believers in this village may be financially poor, but they are rich in faith, love, and spiritual hunger. Their lives reflect the truth of James 2:5 "Has not God chosen those who are poor in the eyes of the world to be rich in faith and to inherit the kingdom He promised those who love Him?" They meet regularly for worship, prayer, and the study of God's Word. Despite challenges, including lack of employment and basic resources, they remain steadfast in faith, generous in spirit, and united in fellowship. At present, the believers do not have a proper facility for their gatherings. Meetings often take place in open areas or cramped homes, affected by weather, noise, and discomfort.
