Everything changed when we heard about Tender Heart and its free education program. We were filled with hope. Today, both of our children are studying for free in a safe and caring environment. 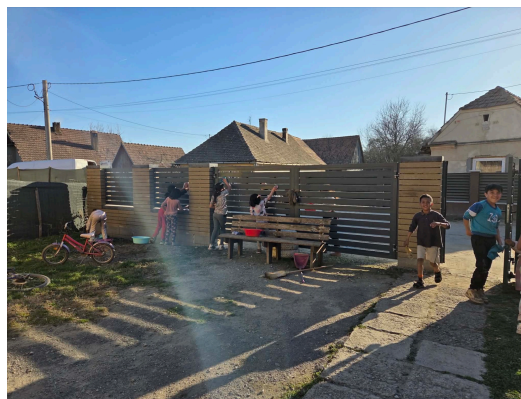
